FOREST PHILHARMONIC 2024-25 SEASON

Welcome to Forest Philharmonic's 2024-25 season. We are delighted to once more be performing a full season of 4 concerts in the year ahead, as well as holding our inaugural North & East London Young Musician of the Year competition. We very much hope that you will be able to join us. Our programme this season will again be rich and varied, including many well-known pieces by familiar composers and some less well-known pieces.
